Vc corridor highway will integrate the region in the European road network in an adequate way.





ECONOMIC INDICATORS

Foreign trade

Through the development of private sector and attracting new investments in the development of small and medium enterprises, Zenica has successfully amortized huge job loss in large systems that have been the backbone of the city's economy. City's administration has decided to take proactive approach in creating favourable ambiance for the development of entrepreneurship, thereby creating favourable conditions for economic development of Zenica City and arrival of new strategic investors.

Opening new manufacturing companies in the period of 2009 – 2015, particularly in the field of metal industry has resulted in a positive trend of continuous reduction of import in the period 2011 - 2014, while in 2015 import was slightly increased. Cyclical trend of increase and decrease was recorded in the export.



EDUCATION



Scientific and academic institutions

City of Zenica is a regional educational centre with developed network of preschool, elementary, secondary, graduate, undergraduate and postgraduate education.

Zenica has the conditions for accommodating preschool children when it comes to space and staff. A total of 13 preschool care institutions, attended by 661 children, operate in the city. Public Institution for Preschool Care and Education has 6 kindergartens under its jurisdiction, while the other 7 kindergartens are a private property. Kindergartens are not evenly distributed through urban and suburban areas, and accordingly there is a commitment to organize preschool care in suburban areas and opening smaller kindergartens.

Elementary education is organized in 45 schools, 18 of them is basic and 27 district schools, which are organized due to the large distance from the main school. In the school year of 2014/2015, 10.328 pupils completed 9-year education.

Secondary education in Zenica City is performed in 11 schools (First Gymnasium, Second Gymnasium, "Saint Paul" General Secondary School, School of Economics, School of Medicine, Technical School, Secondary Mixed School, Mixed Secondary Industrial School, Mixed Secondary School, International Secondary School, Secondary School for professional education and vocational training). In the school year of 2014/2015, 4.865 pupils completed secondary education.

Zenica City as a university city has 8 faculties which were attended by approx. 4.000 students in the academic year of 2014/2015. University in Zenica offers excellent education to students through various departments in undergraduate and graduate education

UNIVERSITY IN ZENICA

Organizational units

The history of higher education in Zenica started 40 years ago when Higher Technical School of metallurgy profession was founded. First faculty was founded in 1961 when the Higher Technical School turned into the Faculty of Metallurgy within the University of Sarajevo.

Faculty of Mechanical Engineering was founded later in 1977. For many years, two mentioned faculties were the backbone of higher education in Zenica, and produced a large number of experts who were important for the industry.

In the post-war years in Zenica, a series of faculties were opened, as projecting departments from other universities (Sarajevo and Tuzla), which was the foundation for establishing the University of Zenica.

University in Zenica was established on the Eighteenth of October, 2000 by the Decision of the Assembly of Zenica – Doboj Canton.



In accordance with level of education



Key sectors

The metal sector of Zenica and surrounding areas has the continuous growth while achieving the best import/export results. This is due to a long tradition in metal and steel industry, competitive cost structure, skilled labor, excellent infrastructure and business friendly environment. Arcelor-Mittal Zenica is the largest company, which hires 2.500 people.

The construction sector is among the strongest and most successful sectors in Zenica. Existing companies offer high quality of works and stay up to date with the latest construction innovations. This sector is represented with 50 small and medium companies, hiring slightly over 1.000 people.

The service sector is a very important part of the local economy. This sector alone generates just about 40% of total income of all business entities in the City of Zenica. There are over 700 registered companies providing a wide range of services such as banking and financial services, transportation and storage services, wholesale and retail service and many other professional and technical services.



Zenica, unlike any other place within the country, provides widespread manufacturing support from beginning to an end – from raw materials, through design, engineering and development phase to production and maintenance support.

Significant domestic sources of energy, coal and electrical power are the biggest advantages of this sector. Additionally, there is a positive trend of export orientation towards financially stronger and more stable markets, which counts for almost 25% of total exports from BiH. Leading export products of this sector are metals, specifically aluminum and steel. The second place belongs to automobile industry, with a steady growth and significant development potential. Metal products also have significant development potential, which is currently the leading export product from this group with a low added value.

Building construction & civil engineering

The main areas in which local construction companies operate are:

The construction sector is an important part of the local economy.

According to official data of the Federal Bureau of Statistics, from 2011 until today, the construction sector in the City of Zenica has recorded continuous growth. Total value of construction works in 2015. amounted for 90.3 million KM, which is by 16% more than in 2014. Building construction counted for \approx 35% of the total works, while remaining 65% was realized in the field of civil engineering. It is important to emphasize that Strategy of local economic development relies, among other things, on construction sector.

Construction companies in the City of Zenica execute all kinds of works. However, there is an increasing number of specialized construction companies in the field of civil engineering, which is becoming very important due to a large scale infrastructure projects in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

This sector is dominated by the large number of SMEs, with a presence of several large companies.

SERVICE SECTOR

The most successful sector in Zenica

Sector of professional and business service in City of Zenica hires over 11.000 people or 45% of total employees. This sector generates 40% of total revenues of business entities in City of Zenica or 806 million of euros (data for 2016).

For several years now this sector is among the strongest and the most successful sectors in City of Zenica, as administrative center of Zenica - Doboj canton.

Sector of Professional and business services has a very important role in the overall economic trends of the City of Zenica, not only because of its scope, but also for horizontal connections with other sectors of the economy in which it operates through technology transfer, innovation, creativity, and improvement of process efficiency. This sector consists of activities which are experiencing rapid growth at the global level and thus have a potential for further growth (IT sector, business consulting etc).

Sector is dominated by the large number of medium, small and micro firms. In total number of 4.983 business entities (ltd companies, business units, crafts), there are 4.204 companies or 84%.

Sector provides opportunities for all sized companies to meet their needs for different kinds of services, at a high quality level and very competitive prices.

This sector consolidates tertiary sector meaning transport, commerce, catering, crafting and banking as well as quaternary sector including education, science, culture, information, healt and social protection.

AGRICULTURAL SECTOR

Big development potentials

The city is represented with a various primary agricultural productions, but due to the fragmented plots and a large percentage of meadows (51%) production of livestock is the most dominant. Milk production is also important because of the presence of milk supply chain and processing capacities (ZIM company). Quantities of purchased milk are increasing constantly. The largest purchaser of milk is "Zenica milk industry" ltd. Zenica (65% of total purchase).

In recent years, farmers have shown interest in planting new orchards of fruit, especially new plants of raspberries as well as for greenhouse production. This contributes to the fact that this area has a several buyers of fruits, which have a significant cold storage capacities and secured placement of frozen products into EU market. These companies DELTA FROST Zenica (subsidiary company Deltra Trade Ltd. Zenica) and GTL "Pronatura" Zenica. In the city there are 56 rural areas and a total of 2,480 registered farms and 97 crafts.

There is an increased tendency of registering crafts in production of livestock and greenhouse production, as wells as of raspberry producers with plantations covering areas of more than 5 dunums of land.

BUSINESS ZONE ZENICA 1

Business Zone Zenica 1 is the primary area for economic development focus and home to a local Business incubator and TechnoPark Zenica – owned by City of Zenica and ran by Zenica's Development Agency ZEDA. Business Zone covers the are of 336.427 m² (84 acres) out of which 60% is already being utilized. The remaining free space can be adjusted to investor's specific needs. Business operations in the business zone are of a diverse nature with the largest being CIMOS, RM-LH, ITC, ZE-STEEL, FE-METALL and treasure all engaged in the metal sector.

Business zone is located between the business complex of ArcelorMittal and the city- as a former part of the large complex has a great connection with the rest of sub-zone roads and rail roads which enables easy flow of goods. The new city ring road by-pass provides immediate access to the Business Zone Zenica 1 from M-17 highway and Vc corridor highway.




AGRO – ZONE NEMILA



BUSINESS INCUBATOR ZENICA

Generator of development of new companies

Launching the Business Incubator in Zenica was the priority project within the Strategy for development of entrepreneurship and SME's and represents one of first steps of its implementation.

Zenica City entrusted the management of Business Incubator to its development agency ZEDA. By forming the Business incubator, we have provided our citizens the optimal conditions for realizing their business idea and support for their business venture, preferably in the initial phase when they need it the most.

Business Incubator Zenica offers a combination of services which enable fast and successful business development. It is a set of infrastructural and competitive advantages that contribute to the entrepreneur. Our basic goal is to arouse entrepreneurial mind-set, develop business culture, promote self-employment and emergence of new enterprises.

- Identification of business possibilities and assessment of new business ideas (business planning),
- Constant support for entrepreneurs by business counselling and joint problem solving,
- Integration with Financial Institutions,
- Technical support for all users of the Incubator,
- Promotion of users which will be done by the Agency during the promotion of the Incubator,
- Introduction of users and their products and services on the Agency's website,
- Information about fairs on local and international level,
- Information about available funds designed to support SME sector.

MUNICIPAL INCENTIVES

Decision on construction land

Fee for utilisation of city construction land is reduced for construction of manufacturing facilities as follows:

- > 40% for manufacturing facility up to 1.000m²
- > 60% for manufacturing facility over 1.000m²
- > 30% for assisting objects

Fee for benefits (rent) for construction of manufacturing facilities is determined by flat rate determined for fifth zone in amount of 20 BAM/m².

Investors are enabled to pay fees in instalments, when constructing manufacturing facilities.

Investors constructing in other business facilities are also enabled to pay fees in instalments, in case when those fees exceed about of 50.000,00 BAM.

Decision on communal fees

Craftsmen engaged in activity regulated by Regulation on the protection of traditional and old crafts are exempt from paying communal fees, as well as craftsmen preforming handicrafts in terms of Law on crafts and similar activities. Companies which employ 50% of persons with disabilities, with minimum of 10 employees, are also exempt from paying communal fees.

On the mayor's proposal City Council may decide on the exemption of tax on company for specific businesses, on the basis of professional and justified opinion of relevant department responsible for monitoring the are in which those subjects operate.

CANTONAL INCENTIVES (ZENICA-DOBOJ CANTON)

Subsidy for the part of administrative costs of investors in manufacturing activities (fee for construction land, fees for the change of designation from construction to agricultural land, utility connection fees, administrative, courts and other fees and charges to panels).

Financial support is foreseen for covering the part of administrative costs for constructing production facilities and purchase of machines and equipment. Craftsmen may obtain funds in the amount of five percent of the total investment, which may range between 10.000,00 BAM and 100.000,00 BAM.

ENTITY INCENTIVES (FEDERATION OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA)

- > The taxpayer who invests, from its own funds, in the production equipment more than 50% of the total profit in the current tax period, shall be reduced of the obligation of the calculated tax for 30% of the amount in the year of investment.
- > The taxpayer who in a period of 5 consecutive years makes investments from its own funds, in the total amount of 10 million €, starting with the first year when taxpayer has to invest at least 2 million €, shall be reduced of the obligations of the calculated tax income for 50% of the amount in the year of investment.
- > The taxpayer is entitled to a tax-deductible expense in the double amount of the gross wage paid to newly employees if meets the following conditions:
 - > Duration of the employment contract must be at least for a period of 12 months with full-time working hour
 - > When new employee was not employed with the taxpayer or a related person in the previous five years.
- > Company business unit of a resident founded, or established, or with the actual administration and control over business outside the territory of the Federation but in Bosnia and Herzegovina shall be exempt from paying the tax on income generated by business operations in the territory of the Federation.

INCENTIVES ON THE STATE LEVEL

State-level incentives are realised on the following grounds via the Indirect Taxation Authority of Bosnia and Herzegovina:

- 1. VAT exemption for import of goods into business zone
- 2. Equipment released for free circulation which represents an investment by a foreign person, except for passenger vehicles, entertainment and slot machines, shall be granted relief of import duty.
- 3. Goods released for free circulation for projects of rebuilding and reconstruction of B&H shall be relieved of import duty.
- 4. Equipment released for free circulation intended for production activity in the free zone shall be relieved of import duty.
- 5. Fixed assets and other equipment belonging to companies that have definitely terminated their activity in a foreign country and transferred it to the customs territory of B&H shall be relieved of duty.
- 6. Relief of duty for products that farmers from B&H obtain in the land situated in a foreign country.
- 7. Relief of import duty on goods imported for trade and promotional purpose

ARCELORMITTAL

Company ArcelorMittal Zenica is doing business in B&H for 13 years, and has approx. 2.400 people directly employed. Total investment since 2004 is estimated to be more than 325 million KM, whereby the investments in environmental protection are in the amount of 100 million KM. Total investment in local community from 2004 is more than two million KM, with more than 280 projects.





DELTAFROST

Delta Trade ltd. Zenica successfully operates in Zenica for 18 years. The company is a significant supplier of seeds, spices and raw materials for the confectionary industry. Recognizing the trends and interest in raspberries and other berry fruits, the company has formed a business unit of Delta Frost. Delta Trade ltd. Zenica has imported and installed the first IQF tunnel in Bosnia and Herzegovina for the needs of its business unit Delta Frost. Installation was put into the operation in June, 2016. Valuation of investment of refrigerator and equipment is 3.5 million KM.

PRONATURA

Farming cooperative Pronatura purchases raspberries and other berry fruits. Refrigerator was installed in 2015 with a capacity of 1,000 tons, or 30 tons of deep freeze in 24 hours. The total investment was 2 million. In 2016 Pronatura has purchased 500 tons of raspberries.

They guarantee purchase of berry fruits, provide education, procurement of raw materials and monitoring production in the field for farmers.

Femetall ltd. Zenica is a company that deals with manufacture and assembly of stainless steel and other metal products.

Within a short period of time, they have acquired a large number of customers and partners in Bosnia and Herzegovina and at the demanding European market.
